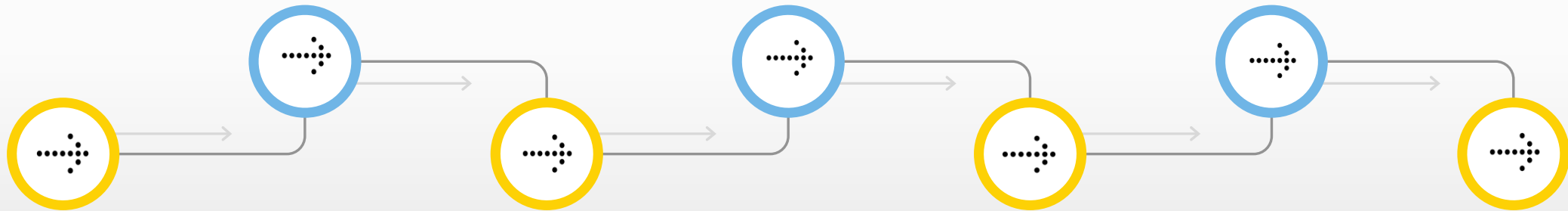


# THE 7 STEPS OF DECISION-MAKING

Take action: Put your choice into practice.



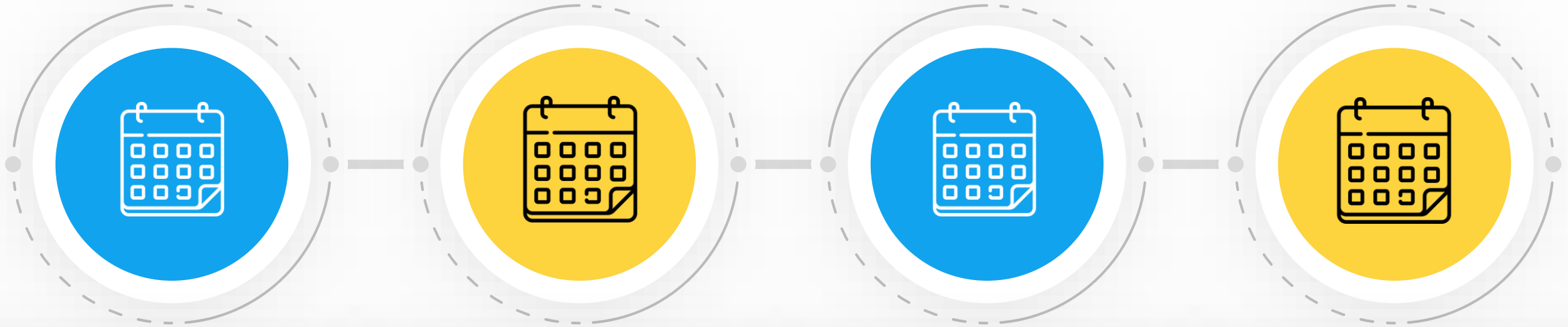
Identify the decision: Define the choice you must make.
